


## **WELCOME**

Thank you for purchasing your Kampa windbreak. Please read these instructions before attempting to set up your windbreak and retain for future reference.

## **UV DEGRADATION**

Fabrics can be weakened by prolonged exposure to sunlight. Under normal holiday use your awning will give long service but use for extended periods in strong sunlight will soon cause deterioration. In those cases it would be wise to use a site as shaded as possible. UV degradation is not covered under the warranty. The warranty does not cover products used on permanent sites, displays or for commercial purposes.



## **SET UP**

- 1. Thread the pole through one of the end sleeves on the windbreak. Spike at top 'spade' at bottom.
- 2. Stand upright, place the 'spade' through the ground and push into the ground. For hard ground the spade can be removed from the upright pole.
- 3. Attach one of the support arms to the spike, adjust the length using the clamp. Peg down through the hole at the bottom of the pole. The support arms should be positioned the same side as the upright pole sleeves.
- 4. Feed a horizontal pole through the sleeve at the top of the windbreak. At this stage you can add the next upright pole.
- 5. Each end of the horizontal pole goes over the top of the spike on the top of the upright poles and over the support pole.
- 6. Complete each section of the windbreak.
- 7. Peg down.
- 8. Make final adjustments ensuring that the upright poles are vertical.
